## **Product Description**

Origin and production: "Forest Born" emphasizes that this activated carbon is of forest origin, i.e. its raw materials such as wood chips, sawdust,

wood flakes, husks, etc. come from the wood of the forest. These wood by-products or resources from sustainably managed forests are carbonized and activated to transform them into activated charcoal with a highly developed pore structure.

Environmental properties: Due to its wood origin, this type of activated carbon is often seen as a more environmentally friendly option, especially when the raw material comes from responsibly managed forests.

Adsorption properties: "Forest Born Activated Carbon" has a strong adsorption capacity and effectively removes organic pollutants, odors and colors from gases and liquids.

Applications: Widely used in water treatment, air purification, solvent recovery, sugar refining, metal extraction and other industrial purification processes.

Packaging and storage: It is usually packed in sealed packages to prevent moisture and contaminants from affecting its performance, and should be stored in a dry place.
